

For the removal of excess skin around the eyes to create a fresher and more youthful appearance.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is a Blepharoplasty?

Blepharoplasty or eyelid/eyebag surgery is a cosmetic procedure to remove excess skin or fat from around the eyes which in turn gives a more youthful and alert appearance. This can be performed on the upper and lower lids.

What are the causes of sagging in the eye area?

As we age the skin around the eye loses its elasticity and the muscles begin to weaken. This causes the skin to become loose and wrinkled and a general sagging takes place causing folds on the upper lid and bulging on the under eye area.

What happens during surgery?

This procedure is performed under local anaesthetic at Woodford Medical. For the upper eyelid surgery a small incision is made along the natural crease of the upper eyelid and the fatty tissue is repositioned and the muscle tightened before carefully stitching to ensure a smooth and line-free result.

For the lower eyelid/eyebag an incision is made along the lower lash line before removing any excess fat commonly known as eye bags. The skin is then stretched to ensure an even finish and delicately stitched into place giving a smooth and bag-free appearance.

How much does this procedure cost?

Every patient is an individual and exact cost will be given and fully explained during your consultation.
